Come & Try Events

Limited to New 2022 Students who have **Not Competed** previously

Competitors (Competitors only) entering by closing date of entries will be granted **Free Entry**.

Competitors do need to register to enter Come & Try Events (No FEE)

Competitors can only dance in **1 Modern and 1 Latin** Come & Try event for free entry

Competitors choosing to compete in Come & Try **and other events** will **cancel Free Entry option**

Competitors dancing in other events must register with Australian Dancing Board (Insurance Cover)

Teacher Medallist Events (Medallist League)

Competitors may be danced at a higher level in their age division where necessary to accommodate all competitors from a studio **at principal's discretion**.

1. Competitor may dance with a Professional or Amateur Teacher. Except where stated otherwise.
2. Each couple must consist of one medallist and a partner.
3. Competitor **must dance within restricted syllabus** for grades up to and including 2nd Bronze (DMIA Bronze Cross, Bronze Star, or Bronze Bar) events
4. Street dress for competitor and partner (off the Rack), **no DanceSport dresses unless dancing in gold and above events**.
5. **Anyone who is paid to teach is not permitted to dance as a competitor.**
6. **Medallist Competitors may dance up one level in each style.**
7. By entering any event you have agreed to abide by the rules and conditions of entry as set down by Dance Masters International Association INC.
8. Dance Masters International Association Inc. Reserve the right of absolute discretion in **all decisions**.
9. All competitors and spectators agree by attending this event, to have their photograph or digital image taken by the DMIA official Photographers.
10. In the event of television coverage, production of a video recording and including any still photographs or digital image taken during the event, may be used for commercial purposes. All competitors or legal guardians agree that the rights to all fees from such recordings will vest with Dance Masters International Association Inc.

Teacher and Students name must be provided when submitting Entry.

Events with less than Four couples may be Combined with another event or deleted at DMIA discretion.
